



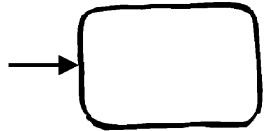
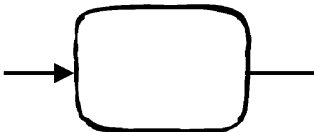
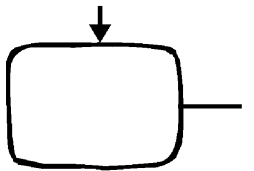
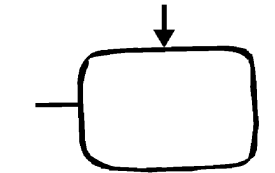
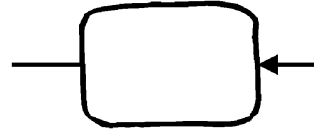
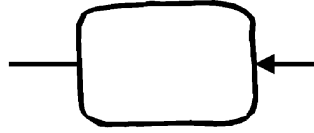
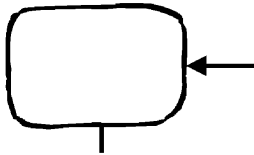
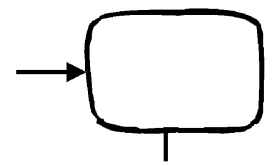
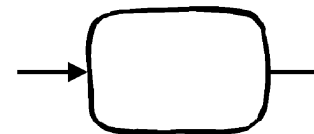
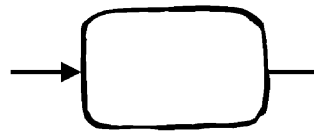
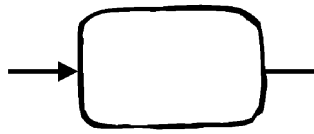
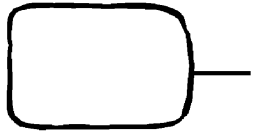
Posters for mat work

Instructions:

1. Print the poster that you would like to use on A4 paper.
2. Using a photocopier machine, make enlarged copies of the posters.
We suggest using white A3 cardboard.
Note: to copy from A4 to A3 you must change the enlargement setting to 141%.
3. Laminate the A3 posters.
4. You can now use a white-board marker, or non-permanent overhead marker, to write on the posters. This way you can wipe off what you have written and use the same poster again for another activity.

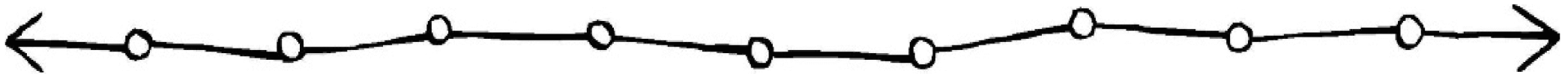
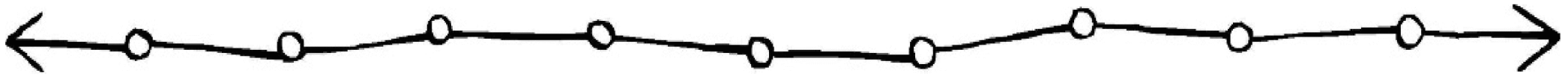

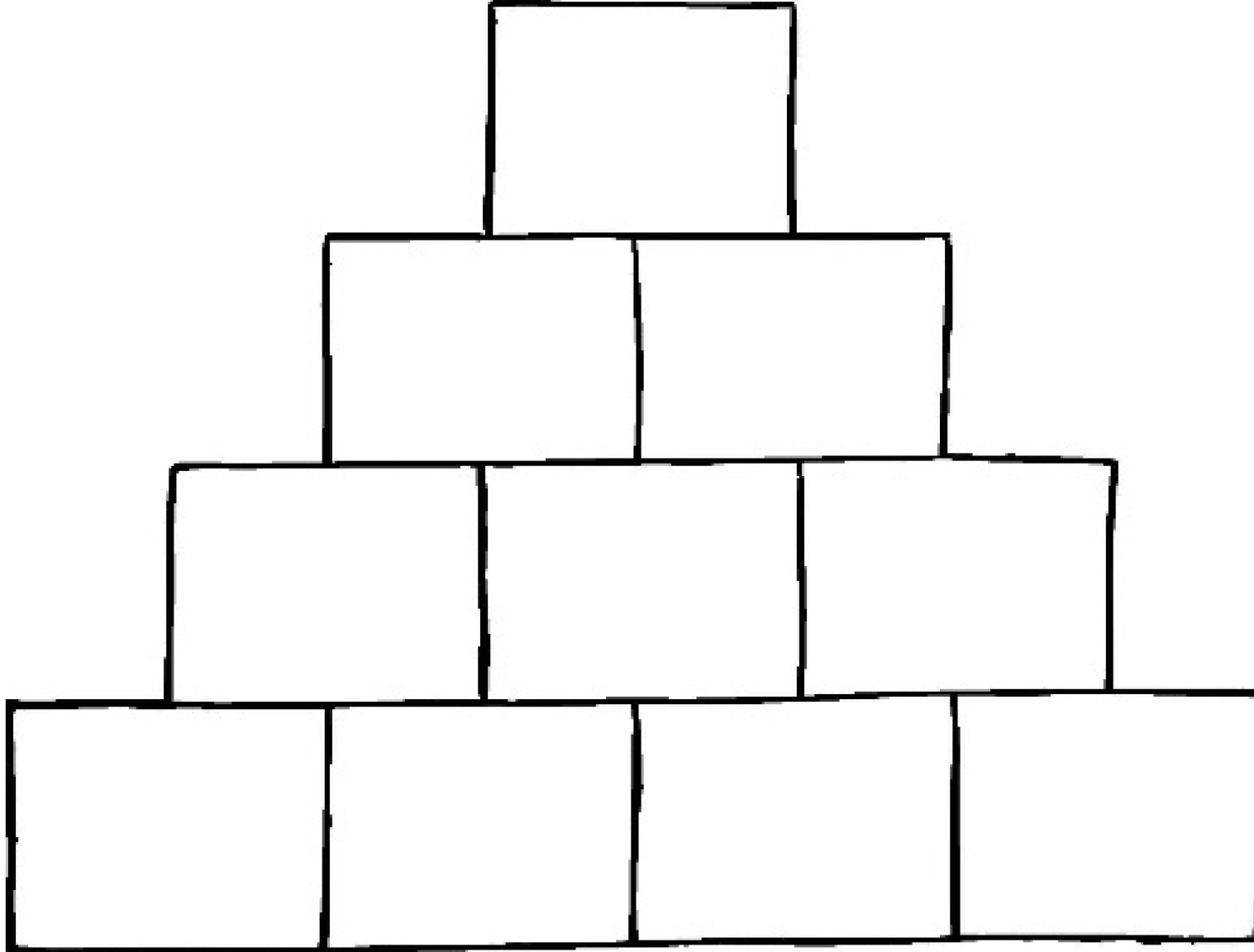


Number Lines



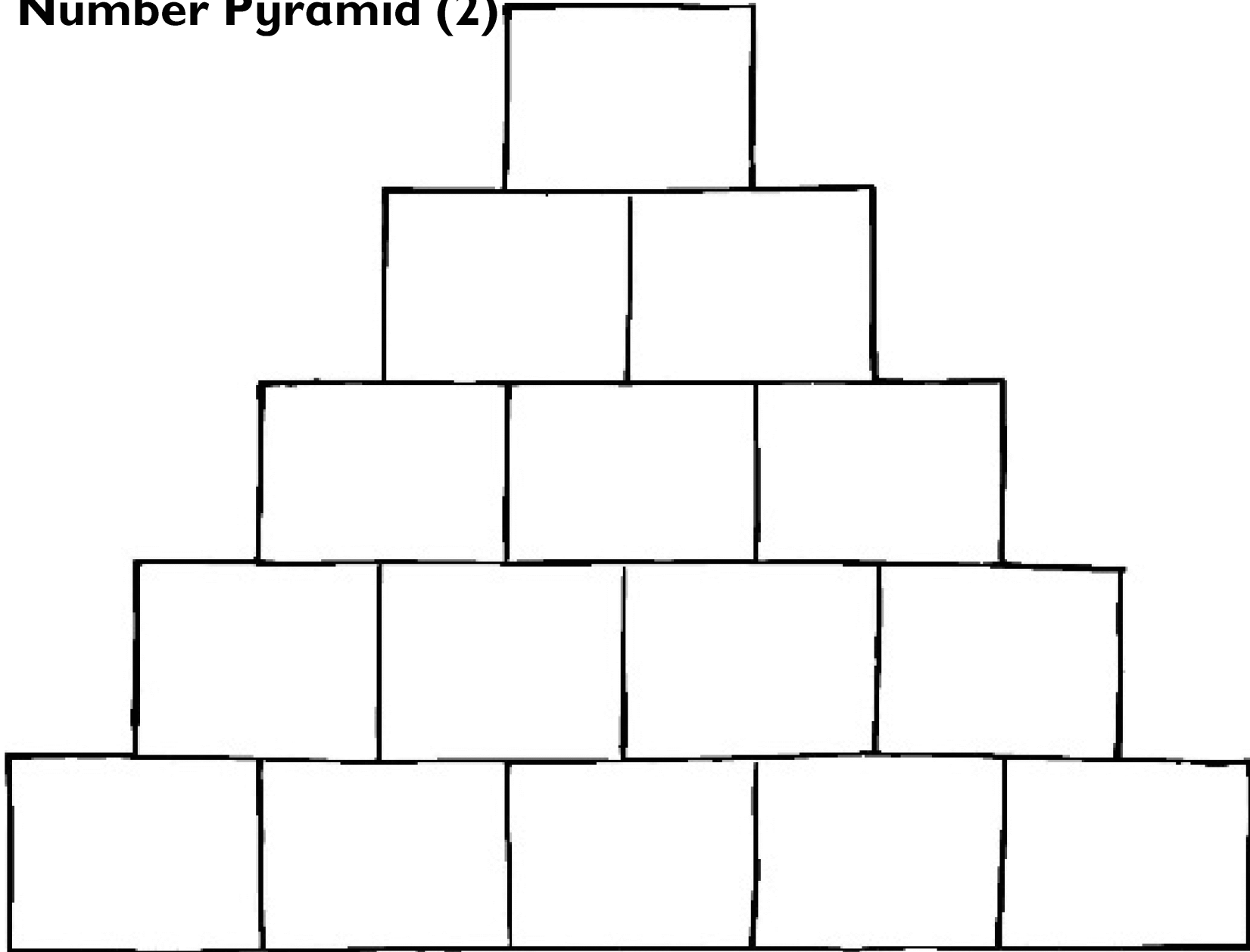


Number Pyramid



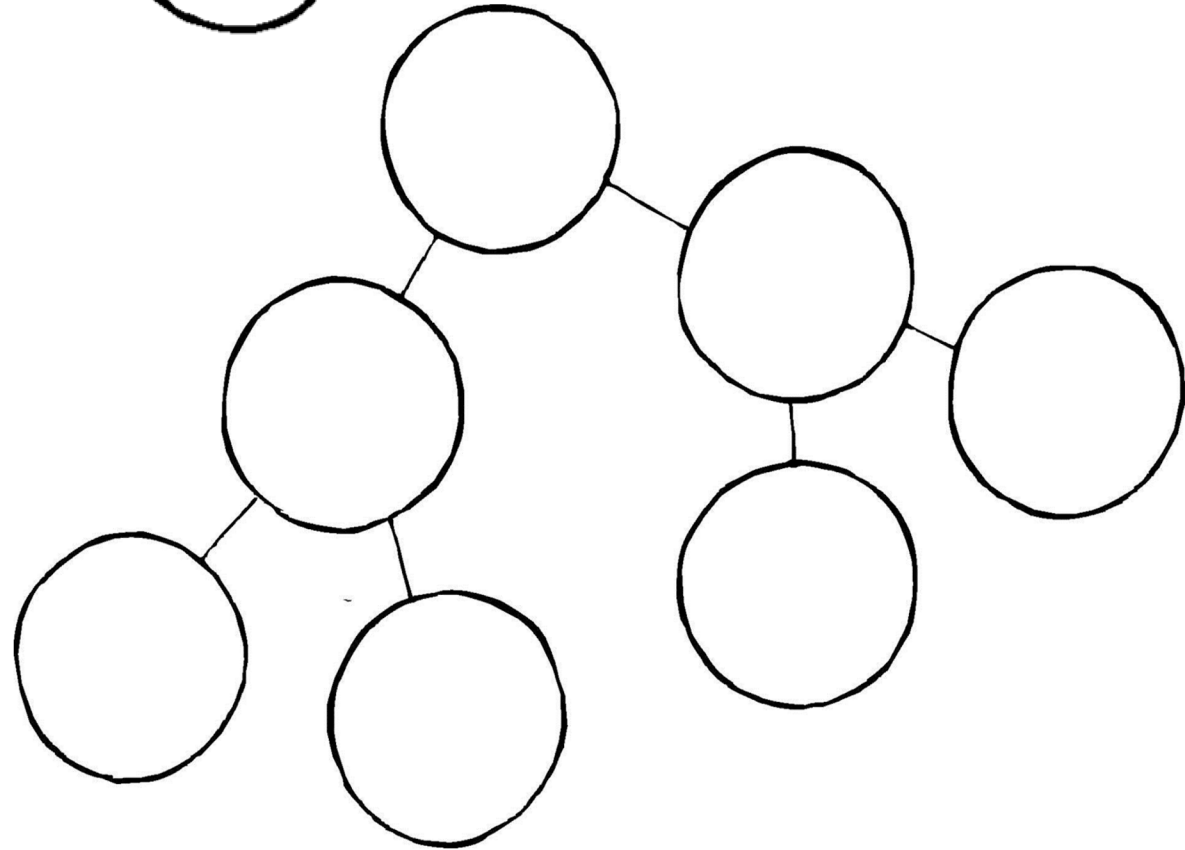
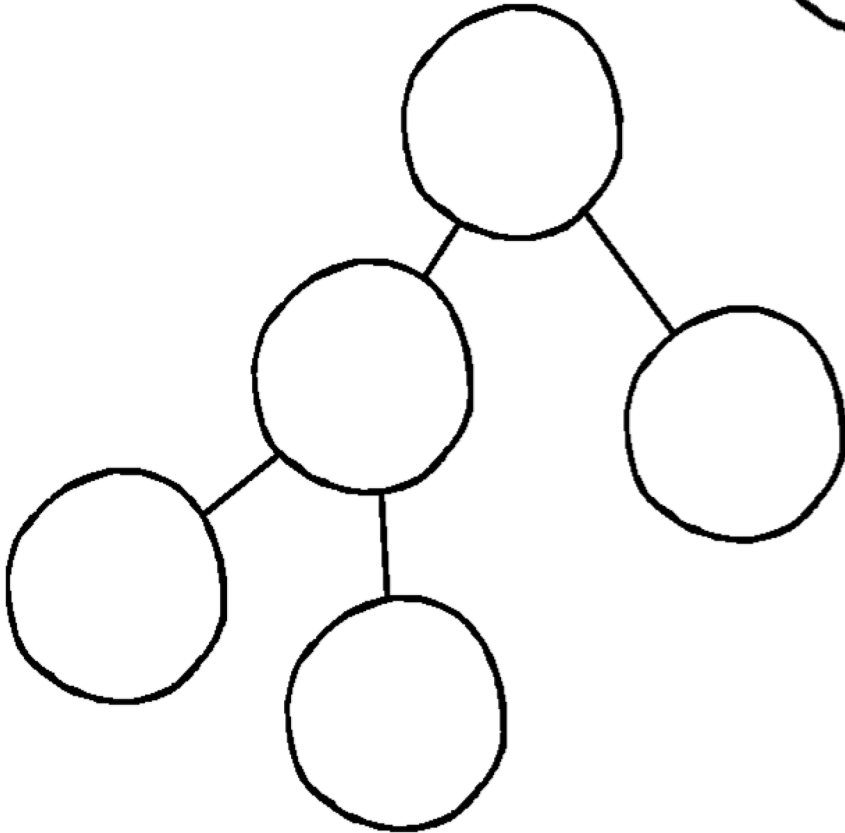
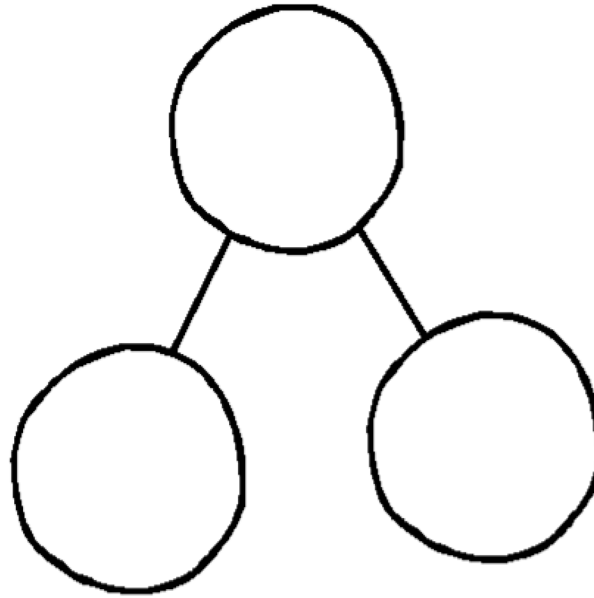


Number Pyramid (2)

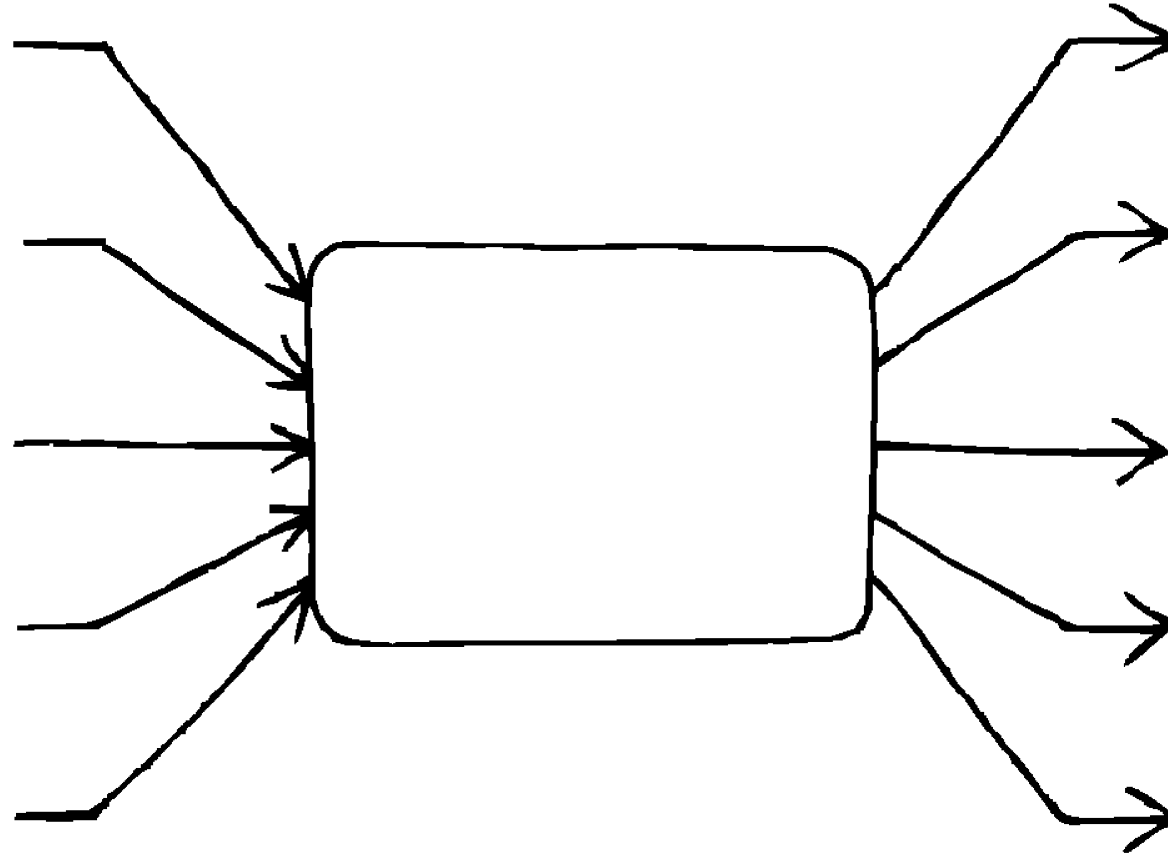

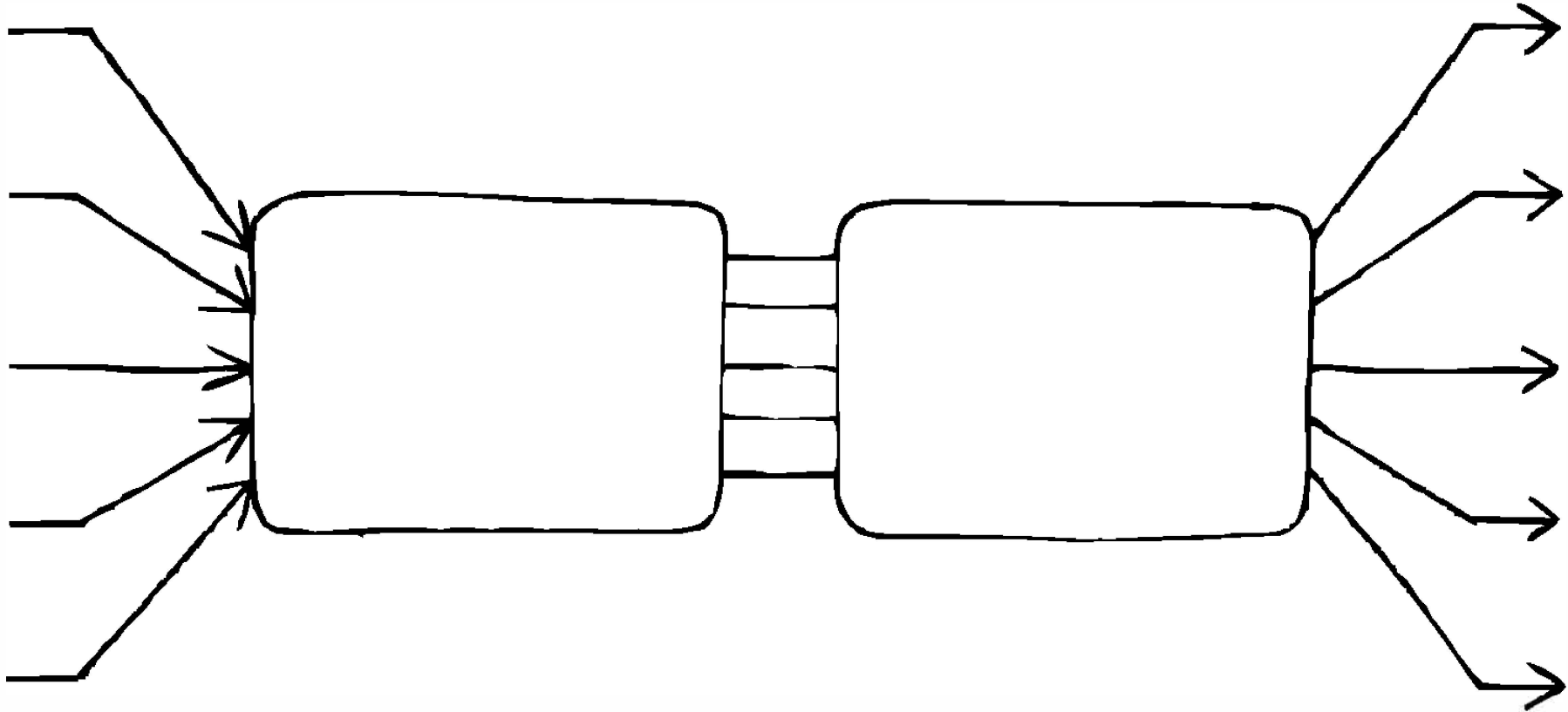


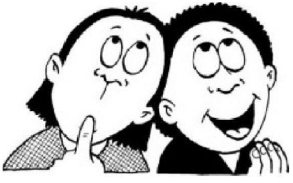
Flow Diagram
